

YOU THE JURY

ONE DAY COURSE FRIDAY 5 APRIL 2019

Diane Janes, an expert on historical crime and author of four books on real life historical murders, has offered to undertake a one day course entitled "You The Jury". Participants will consider the evidence in respect of two different real life cases of murder, or suspected murder, which occurred in England and Wales between 1900 and 1975. All the cases have been personally researched by the tutor and selected with an eye to the insight they can give us on various aspects of our judicial system, or social history. Participants are expected to listen to the evidence, making notes as they go, then discuss the case and attempt to reach a verdict. A pen, notebook and an open mind are all that is required, no advanced research is needed.

The session will begin at 9.45 am and finish between 5 and 5.30 pm with breaks during the morning and afternoon and an hour for lunch.

It is suggested that participants bring their own lunch, tea/coffee and biscuits will be supplied.

The venue will be the Lower Classroom at Holy Trinity Parish Centre and the cost will be £15.00 to cover the tutor's fee and a contribution to the room hire charge. Advanced payment will be required to book your place.
